


#### **Directions to our Parish:**

#### Fr. Panapiotis' Message





One of the most impressive things Christ did during His earthly ministry is healing. "And he went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the gospel of the kingdom and healing ( $\theta \epsilon \rho \alpha \pi \epsilon \psi \omega v$ ) every disease and every infirmity among the people." (Matthew 4:23)

He saw the pain and suffering of the people and responded by healing them: "As he went ashore he saw a great throng; and he had compassion on them, and healed (ἐθεράπευσεν) their sick." (Matthew 14:14) But while we have no special comments from Him when He heals the multitudes, there are several cases recorded by the Evangelists where He associated the healing of the person with their

strong faith. For example, He healed the woman with the flow of blood saying to her: "Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you well (ἡ πίστις σου σέσωκέν σε)." (Matthew 9:22) He healed the blind man saying "Receive your sight; your faith has made you well (Aνάβλεψον ἡ πίστις σου σέσωκέν σε)." (Luke 18:42; see also Mark 10:52) and to the healed paralytic who returns to thank Him falling down on his knees, He says: "Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well." ('Αναστὰς πορεύου' ἡ πίστις σου σέσωκέν σε. (Luke 17:19))

Christ singles out these specific individuals to point out the connection between their faith and their healing, but uses a different verb to describe this healing. While in the general cases of healing of the multitudes the verb used is ἐθεράπευσεν, in the specific cases the verb is σέσωκέν. This is the same verb that we translate as "saved" in English. In other words, His response is that "Your faith has saved you!" This holistic saving healing, it seems to me, is the ultimate, superior healing that Christ has brought to us. He has not come to heal our sicknesses and infirmities in the flesh alone, but He has come to heal our whole humanity, our body and soul. Our body may live a few more years, perhaps, but our soul will live forever. God will resurrect the body again by His power in the end times, but we are the only ones who can raise up our souls through our faith in Him and our humble trust in His love.

Many times, people misunderstand this connection between faith and the *holistic saving healing* and emphasize only the healing of the flesh through faith. It is clear that we must examine the New Testament in its original language in order to see these important theological nuances. It is necessary for us as Greek Orthodox Christians who are the inheritors of the Hellenic heritage to support the study of the Biblical texts in the original language in order to understand the exact meaning of the Holy Scriptures and the precise Will of God for us.

Join me, my brothers and sisters, to help build a Hellenic Studies Program in our parish that will be available to all Christians in this area who desire to study the New Testament in its original language. We should be able to provide a witness to the local community of the Ancient Faith, as it has been handed down to us, in yet one more way.

#### ST. THEODORA THE EMPRESS

COMMEMORATED FEBRUARY 11

Anyone bearing the name Theodora must feel an inner pride in having been so named. It not only means the "gift of God," but is also the namesake of one of the most noble women of the Christian Church. Theodora was the wife of Theophilos, Emperor of the Byzantine Empire during the ninth century, when the Empire was at its zenith and emcompassed the entire civilized world. During that period iconoclasm was a strong movement which swept the Empire. The supporters of the iconoclastic movement believed that icons should be purged from the church. They thought that veneration of icons was tantamount to idolatry. In fact, some Christians of that time, influenced by the pagan religion from which they converted, treated icons as oblects of worship. As a reaction against this false understanding of the place of icons in Orthodox worship, many favored the complete elimination of icons.

Believing that they were fighting against idolatry, some Emperors issued decrees banishing icons from the churches and persecuting anyone possessing icons. Theophilos was such an iconoclast Emperor. But icons were finally restored due to the efforts of his most noble wife, Theodora secretly possessed many icons. Firm in the belief that the time has come when the icons should once again resume their rightful place in the house of God, shortly after the death of Emperor Theophilos Empress Theodora, acting as regent for her son Michael III, convoked a Council in 843 A.D which formally accepted the decision of the Seventh Ecumenical Council of 787 affirming the use of icons in Orthodox worship. The council explained that veneration is paid to Christ and the saints depicted on the icons, and not to the material substance of paint and wood.

This historic decision is celebrated each year in the Orthodox Church on the first Sunday of Great Lent, known as the Sunday of Orthodoxy. Thus, Empress Theodora gave all her support to the recognition of Holy Icons as essential elements of Orthodox worship, and in so doing proved to be an instrument of God's glory. In her lifetime she revealed her true nature to be more religious than civic, and through her faith and devotion to Christ she helped the Church to grow and prosper. With her precious icons before her, she died on February 11, 859 A.D., and was recognized as a true champion of the Orthodox Faith.


